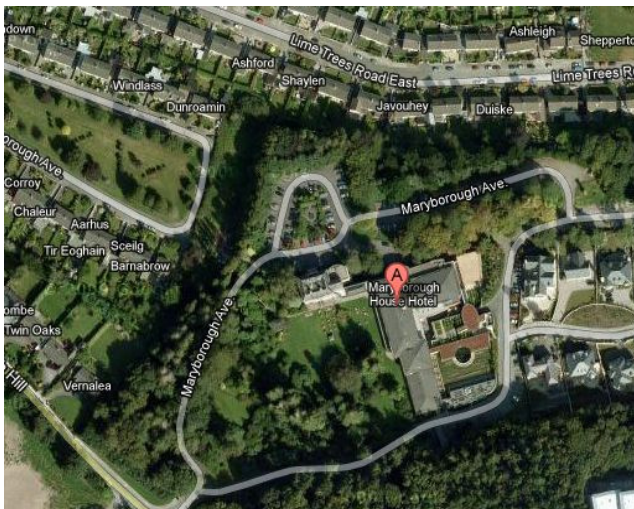


Maryborough House Hotel

GPS: Latitude - N 51 52.375 Longitude - W 8 25.082

From Kinsale Road Roundabout

Take 4th exit onto South Ring road - N25 East
Once on N25, take 2nd exit for Douglas, ignoring 1st exit marked for Douglas West. At the traffic lights, turn right
At the roundabout, take 2nd exit traveling straight ahead
At the traffic lights, drive straight on, until you reach a second roundabout. Take 3rd exit off roundabout (Douglas Golf Club on directional fingerpost). This is Maryborough Hill; the hotel is situated up the hill on the left hand side.

From Jack Lynch Tunnel

Follow N40 to N28. Take the N28 exit from N40. Take Rochestown Road/R610 to Maryborough Hill .Merge onto N28. Take the R610 exit toward Douglas / Rochestown .At the roundabout, take the 4th exit onto Rochestown Road/R610 . At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Maryborough Hill .The hotel is situated up the hill on the left hand side
